1	The insecticide Analysts Ms. M. Ratna Manjula and Mr. Sudhakar Raju, did they undergo the mandatory 66 days training programme?	The Insecticide Analysts, Ms. M. Ratna Manjula and Mr. Sudhakar Raju did not undergo the mandatory 66 days training program on Pesticide Formulation Analysis.
2	Is there any separate lab to test the bio products samples?	Pesticide Management Division of NIPHM has separate facilities to test bio-product samples.
3	What is the percentage of residue allowed to pass or fail a sample as bio products are analysed along with pesticides?	The bio-products are not analysed along with pesticide samples. The test reports do not mention / specify either pass or fail.
4	What are the objectives of NIPHM and are they authorized to do testing by the CIB?	Vide Gazettee Notification No. 132, Dated March 12, 2013, In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to section 16 of the Insecticide Act, 1968 (46 of 1968), read with rule 5 of Insecticide Rules, 1971, the Central Government directed the following function of Central Insecticide Laboratory in respect on bio-pesticides shall be carried by National Institute of Plant Health Management, Hyderabad, namely, a. To analyse such samples of bio-pesticides sent to it under the Act by any other officer or authority authorized by the Central or State Governments and submission of certificates of analysis to the concerned authority; b. सा.का.नि. 166(अ)—केन्द्रीय सरकार, कीटनाशी नियम, 1971 के नियम 5 के साथ पठित कीटनाशी अधिनियम, 1968 (1968 का 46) की धारा 16 के प्रस्तुत द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए यह निर्देश देती है कि राष्ट्रीय वनस्पति स्वास्थ्य प्रबंधन संस्थान, हैदराबाद द्वारा जीव-नाशकजीवमार के बावत केन्द्रीय कीटनाशी के निम्नलिखित कृत्य किए जाएंगे, अर्थात् :—

- केन्द्रीय या राज्य सरकारों द्वारा प्राधिकृत किसी अधिकारी या प्राधिकारी द्वारा उसको अधिनियम के अधीन पंजे गए जीव-नाशकजीवमार के ऐसे नमूनों का विश्लेषण करना और संबद्ध प्राधिकारी को विश्लेषण का प्रमाणपत्र प्रस्तुत करना;
- अधिनियम के उपबंधों के अधीन रसायनिक पदार्थ के लिए जीव-नाशकजीवमार के नमूनों का विश्लेषण करना;
- ऐसे पंच रजिस्ट्रीकरण अन्वेषण करना जो नाशकजीवमार के रजिस्ट्रीकरण की शर्तों को सुनिश्चित करने के प्रयोजन के लिए आवश्यक हो;
- रजिस्ट्रीकृत जीव-नाशकजीवमार के प्रभावकारिता और विषाक्तता का अवधारण करना।

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 12th March, 2013

G.S.R. 166(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Section 16 of the Insecticides Act, 1968 (46 of 1968), read with rule 5 of the Insecticides Rules, 1971, the Central Government hereby directs that the following functions of the Central Insecticides Laboratory in respect of bio-pesticides shall be carried out by National Institute of Plant Health Management, Hyderabad, namely :—

- to analyse such samples of Bio pesticides sent to it under the Act by any officer or authority authorized by the Central or State Governments and submission of certificates of analysis to the concerned authority;
- to analyse samples of Bio pesticides for chemical substance under the provisions of the Act;
- to carry out such post registration investigations as may be necessary for the purpose of ensuring the conditions of Registration of pesticides;
- to determine the efficacy and toxicity of registered Bio pesticides.
