

International Training on Pest Risk Analysis

5 days from 1 – 5 September, 2014

Background Information:

Global trade in agriculture has increased many-folds in the past few decades. The trade liberalization has opened the floodgates of entry for exotic pests to cut-across the geographic boundary. Realizing the importance to regulate commodities to prevent entry, establishment and spread of alien species, it is important to analyse the pests associated with pathway of importing commodity and to identify appropriate Phytosanitary measures. Pest Risk Analysis (PRA) is a process which helps to identify potential pests that are associated with the pathway at the exporting country and helps to identify mitigation measures to facilitate pest-free trade. The plant pest incursions in the past and recent times are examples of what damages the introduced pests can do to the livelihood, availability of agricultural produce, environment and tourism. Realizing the positive role of Pest Risk Analysis to prevent such pests from moving across the globe, WTO-SPS measures deems it fit to notify commodities based on scientific rationale of PRA.

Pest Risk Analysis (PRA) plays vital role in facilitating pest free trade through analysis of potential risks and employing appropriate Phytosanitary measures. The lectures and the classes during the training will be handled by faculty trained in USA in addition to International faculty from USDA. The training is a combination of lectures and classroom exercises to cover the important concepts of Pest Categorization, Pest Risk Assessment, Pest Risk Management, Appropriate Phytosanitary measures to be employed, Systems Approach, etc.

Training Details:

NIPHM in collaboration with USDA is organizing **5 days International Training on Pest Risk Analysis from 1 – 5 September, 2014**. International participants from South Africa, Zambia, Ethiopia, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bhutan, Indonesia and Bangladesh are likely to participate in the training programme. The PRA training programme will be useful for Scientists, Teaching Faculty, Extension officials and Regulatory officials of DPPQ&S.

Nominations are invited for participation in the International Training on Pest Risk Analysis. Nominations in the prescribed format may be forwarded to NIPHM on or before 25th August, 2014. The selected participants will be provided with **free lodging and boarding in the campus** and in addition **reimbursement of travel expenses**. The reimbursement of travel expenses will be subjected to shortest route from place of posting to NIPHM and back, for the entitled class but restricted to II-tier AC rail fare on the production of original tickets / vouchers.
