Rodent Pests are cause of concern in Agriculture, Horticulture, Food grain and commodity storage, and Public Health sectors. The crop damage made by them varies from 5 to 15% contributing significantly to the productivity of cereal, pulse, oilseed and plantation crops. The loss caused by them to food grain and commodity storage is about 2.5% in the country.
