The main thrust activity is popularizing the Plant Protection Technology among the farming communities and extension functionaries of Central, State/UTs/ Public /Private Sectors, and other Non-Governmental Organizations.

About Workshop:

The objective of the workshop is to enhance the knowledge of extension functionaries in the areas of Plant protection Techniques in selecting right equipment, nozzle and dosage. It also aims to provide policy support to Government in the area of Plant Protection. Right plant Protection equipment for our Indian Agriculture is a big challenge in near future. There is lot of emphasis to be shared equally among Authorities and Industry representatives. There is an urge for minimizing the pesticide application in order to safe guard our people from chemical contamination and as well as from environmental pollution. This workshop helps the stake holders to bridge the gap and address the lacunas in the area of Plant Protection Techniques.

Keeping the importance of this burning issue, NIPHM is going to organise workshop on Plant Protection Techniques from 6 to 7th March, 2019. This workshop can play a vital role in enhancing the scientific effort to enable India's agriculture and horticulture to minimize the pesticide application through the right techniques and diminish the environmental impact of harmful plant pests and diseases.

Nominations are requested from Govt. Organisation /Institute /University to attend the workshop. NIPHM will provide lodging and boarding free of cost and reimbursement of travel charges. The travel expenses will be reimbursed subject to shortest route from place of posting to NIPHM and back, for the entitled class but restricted to II-tier AC rail fare on the production of original tickets/vouchers. DA will not be paid by NIPHM.

Faculty working in self-financing /NGOs /KVKs/ Industries /students are admitted to programme on payment basis. Two officials per Institution may be nominated to attend the workshop.
