**Notification for Forced Hot Air Treatment (FHAT) training as per NSPM-9**

1. National Institute of Plant Health Management (NIPHM), Hyderabad is an autonomous organization functioning under Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India. As per provisions given in NSPM – 9, institute is organizing training on FHAT to all the stakeholders as per their eligibility i.e. matric pass as given in NSPM – 9.
2. Due to COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent lock down and other guidelines issued by the Govt. of India, we could not able to undertake the training from April 2020.
3. In view of the above situations and subsequent relaxations given by the Govt. of India and State Govt. of Telangana, the first batch of FHAT training will be conducted from **15.03.2021 to 19.03.2021** (5 days) for the applications / request received from the stakeholders till 01.03.2021.
4. Also in view of the requirements from stakeholders, two special training programmes will be conducted from **26 to 30.04.2021 and 24 to 28.05.2021** for which applications will be received only through online and interested participants have to register in <https://niphm.gov.in> website.
5. Subsequent batches for FHAT training will be as per the training calendar for the year 2021-22 i.e. **12 to 16.07.2021, 22 to 26.11.2021 and 21 to 25.02.2022** for which applications will be received only through online and interested participants have to register in <https://niphm.gov.in> website.
6. Please note that all the eligible candidates who require FHAT training will be trained in a phased manner.
7. All the candidates who will be coming to NIPHM for training have to follow all the COVID-19 preventive protocols and should carry COVID-19 negative certificate which was taken within 5 days from the day they reach NIPHM.
