Objective of the course

The objective of the course is to create a pool of trained technicians with capacity to manage pest control operations efficiently and to help them have latest knowledge and understanding of biology, identification, habitats and management of various household insect pests and its effective management practices for the end user.

- Minimum Age: The candidate should have completed 18 years of age.
