About NIPHM

NIPHM is an Autonomous Organization under Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Government of India, promoting bio intensive plant health management, stemming from the effects of indiscriminate use of agro chemicals. The main thrust activity is popularizing the plant protection technology among the farming communities and extension functionaries of Central, State/UTs/ Public /Private Sectors, and other Non-Governmental Organizations.

About AICRP on FIM Center

The ICAR sponsored scheme is working with the mandate of identifying the mechanization gaps and future needs of improved farm equipment and machinery for different agro-climatic regions, crops and operations, and to conduct research and development, prototype production, feasibility testing, front line demonstration and promote custom hiring of farm equipment and machinery to bridge identified mechanization gaps.

About Workshop:

The objective of the workshop is to enhance the knowledge of extension functionaries in the areas of farm mechanization in selecting right equipment, from sowing to harvesting. Small and marginal farmers (< 2 ha of farm size) continue to remain at the center of Indian agriculture. However, mechanizing small lands for farming is against economics of scale, especially for operations like land preparation, and harvesting. With continued reduction in average farm size, individual ownership of agricultural machinery will be progressively

uneconomical. The challenge to policy makers will then involve the task of not only leveraging farm mechanization for enhancing agricultural productivity, but also how to include the large community of small and marginal farmers into the fold of mechanized farming. In this context a workshop is proposed to have discussions and deliberations for better mechanization strategies for small and marginal farms.

Nominations are invited for the workshop from Organisation / Institute /University. NIPHM will provide lodging and boarding free of cost and reimbursement of travel charges for the officials of State and Central Govt. organizations as per institute norms.

THEME:

- Custom hiring and feasibility
- Multiplication of custom hiring centers
- Mechanization strategies and facilitates available across the country
- Knowledge sharing through participants
- Policy development in custom hiring

A brief overview of the present mechanization level and strategies being adopted in the work area may be presented by the participants through a power point presentation (of about 10 min duration) during the workshop. This will give a platform to expand the level of mechanization to other areas where similar technologies and adoptions are feasible, but not presently available. Hence, a nationwide plan of action for better custom hiring methods may be drawn through the workshop.
