



Training on “Phytosanitary Inspection” for inspection of Plants /Plant products and other regulated articles in export

National Institute of Plant Health Management (NIPHM), Hyderabad is organizing an exclusive training program on “*Phytosanitary Inspection*” for *thirty days* to impart training pertained to *NSPM-23* “Guidelines for Phytosanitary Service Agency (PSSA) and Phytosanitary Service Provider (PSSP) for inspection of Plants/Plant products and other regulated articles in export”.



This training will enable the phytosanitary inspector’s to acquire technical skills and competency in performance of phytosanitary inspection for export consignments of plants/plant products and other regulated articles meeting the phytosanitary requirements of importing country and thereby fulfilling the international obligations under the International Plant Protection Convention (IPPC) and WTO-SPS Agreement.

Age limit for PSSP: The Entry age– not more than 45Years

Educational Qualifications : Master degree in Agriculture/ Zoology/ Botany/ Plant Protection with specialization in Entomology or Plant Pathology or Nematology or Weed Science or Agronomy.

Training Venue: NIPHM, Hyderabad

In view of the above, first batch of training programme is scheduled from 01.10.2020 to 30.10.2020 and second batch of training programme from 01.01.2021 to 30.01.2021 .*However these dates may vary based on the pandemic situation prevails in the country.*



Fees: Consolidated fees for the training programme is **Rs 30,000/-** (inclusive of GST, boarding, lodging and course fees).
